

Examples of objectives at different levels

Make sure you choose an objective (verb) which is at the right level for assessing skills, knowledge and/or attitudes i.e. to *list* is easier than to *evaluate*. You could make your own list using verbs which relate to your particular subject at different levels.

If you are assessing a qualification, the objectives might be stated for you as part of the assessment criteria, and may differ to the examples and levels below.
